Skeyes and Maharat appeal the Lebanese Interior Minister and the Security Authorities to reveal the fate of Syrian activists who were kidnapped in Beirut

We demand the need for applying legal process in dealing with activists and people with independent opinion, and enable them to defend themselves, in order to preserve the Lebanese values that we always had, in which we work as defenders of freedom of expression and as human rights activists to maintain it and preserve the Declaration of Human Rights, which Lebanon agreed to and signed.
